>>> FACILITY IMPROVEMENT NARATIVE

The improvements to the stadium will be a complete overhaul of the baseball/softball field inside the stadium, which will include shifting the infield away from the football/soccer field, an all-dirt infield to accommodate all ages, collegiate level portable pitching mound, new backstop, roofed dugout, batting cage, bull pens, and press box. This renovation will also capture the passion and pride of the Shippensburg community in our veterans and athletes.

>>> IMPROVEMENT DESCRIPTION

- All-Dirt Baseball/Softball Infield (\$35,000) Installation of an all-dirt infield will consist of
 removing of grass area and 4 inches of dirt. The grass
 and dirt will be replaced with Diamond-Tex Premium
 Infield Mix and collegiate level portable pitching
 mound for baseball.
- **Backstop (\$34,000)** The new backstop will have a 4'x 60' wall directly behind home plate with a black baseball grade netting extending upward from the wall attached to new 6" poles.
- Roofed Dugouts (\$3,000) These dugouts will have a 4' chain link fence enclosing the dugouts. We will purchase a 40'x12' waterproof sun sail to use as the roof for both dugouts. There will be a chain link fence placed in front of the dugout to protect the players.
- Miscellaneous Items (\$8,000)
 - Batting Cage
 - Bull Pens
 - Press Box








>>> BENEFIT OF IMPROVEMENTS
